- In Vlean, all nobles must be Septons
- Represent the Sept as a whole, and not individual Gods.

Chosen:

- Individuals favored by a specific God
- Dedicated to a single deity
- Act in the interest of their patron deity

Relationship between Septons and Chosen:

- Some individuals are both Septons and Chosen, some are only one or the other.
- When acting as a Chosen, an individual follows the specific ideals of their patron deity
- When acting as a Septon, they represent the broader ideals of the Sept

How to Find Runesnails

If this is the first time you've heard of runesnails, you either didn't read my previous article or don't get involved with rare zoological findings. Either way, I am still desperately in need of some more specimens. My research into runesnail's ability to purify magic will be a boon for a variety of problems, including areas previously thought too corrupted. I write this article to once again seek help and answer some common questions I received.



- *Where are they?* Runesnails are typically found in the Freelands as they are attracted to areas where magic has been cast or is particularly seeping into the ground. Because adventurers don't practice safe spell casting, runesnails might converge on an area of a failed ritual or other magical idiocy.
- *Can I make a lure?* Yes! A runesnail lure usually involves a small magical item, such as a ring. Place the ring on a tree stump and arrange a circle around it (with pebbles or other objects). This combination tends to make magic more appealing to them. If you're worried about theft, you can cover everything in leaves. The runesnail will still sense it.
- *Did I find a runesnail?* If it is roughly the size of your thumb or as large as half a human male's hand, you likely found a runesnail. Other hints are that they are blue, possibly glowing if they just fed, and have rune-like markings on their shell.

This affliction causes individuals to transform into monstrous creatures known as Veilwalkers. There is a lot of rumor and scrutiny regarding this new contagion, and research into how to find a cure is still ongoing. Here are the facts so far:

How the Infection Spreads:

- **Only Veilwalkers Spread the Infection:** The infection can only be transmitted by those who have already transformed into Veilwalkers or are in the advanced stages of infection.
- **Initial Infection:** Individuals with the initial signs of infection, known as having a "blemish", are not contagious. This "blemish" appears differently on each infected individual. While most seem to develop a very disgusting boil, one faekin's hair color changed.

Treatment and Prevention:

- **Drink a Tonic:** The only known remedy to slow the infection is a Blightfyre Tonic, only obtainable through trade with Varganien. The exact mechanism, potential side effects, and how the tonic is made remain unclear.
- **Avoid Adventuring:** Many

of the infected individuals are adventurers. Not becoming an Adventurer seems to be the best method of avoiding infection.

- **Stay Away from Maplewood:** The southern region surrounding Maplewood is currently the epicenter of the infection. Staying away from that area will also lessen your chances of infection.
- **Find God:** Draconus is currently offering a cure to anyone who will complete an ordeal for him. Any of his chosen are able to give you this ordeal.

Encountering a Veilwalker:

- **Run Away:** Veilwalkers are capable of short bursts of speed but quickly tire. It is in your best interests to run far away to somewhere they cannot find you.
- **Seek Sanctuary:** Magical barriers can protect against Veilwalkers. If you are able to find a Sanctuary, this is your best chance of waiting them out.
- **Dissipate:** If you know how to dissipate, you should do this as fast as possible to avoid contact. Carrying a potion of dissipate is highly recommended for those that are unable to do so on their own.
